What is an RSS News Feed?

- Real Simple Syndication
- a content delivery vehicle

- Feed – distribution of content
- Think of RSS as your own personal wire service.

News Feed vs Email

- Subscription is anonymous; you don't provide your email address.
- Information is updated instantly
- You get all the latest news without having to search the web.

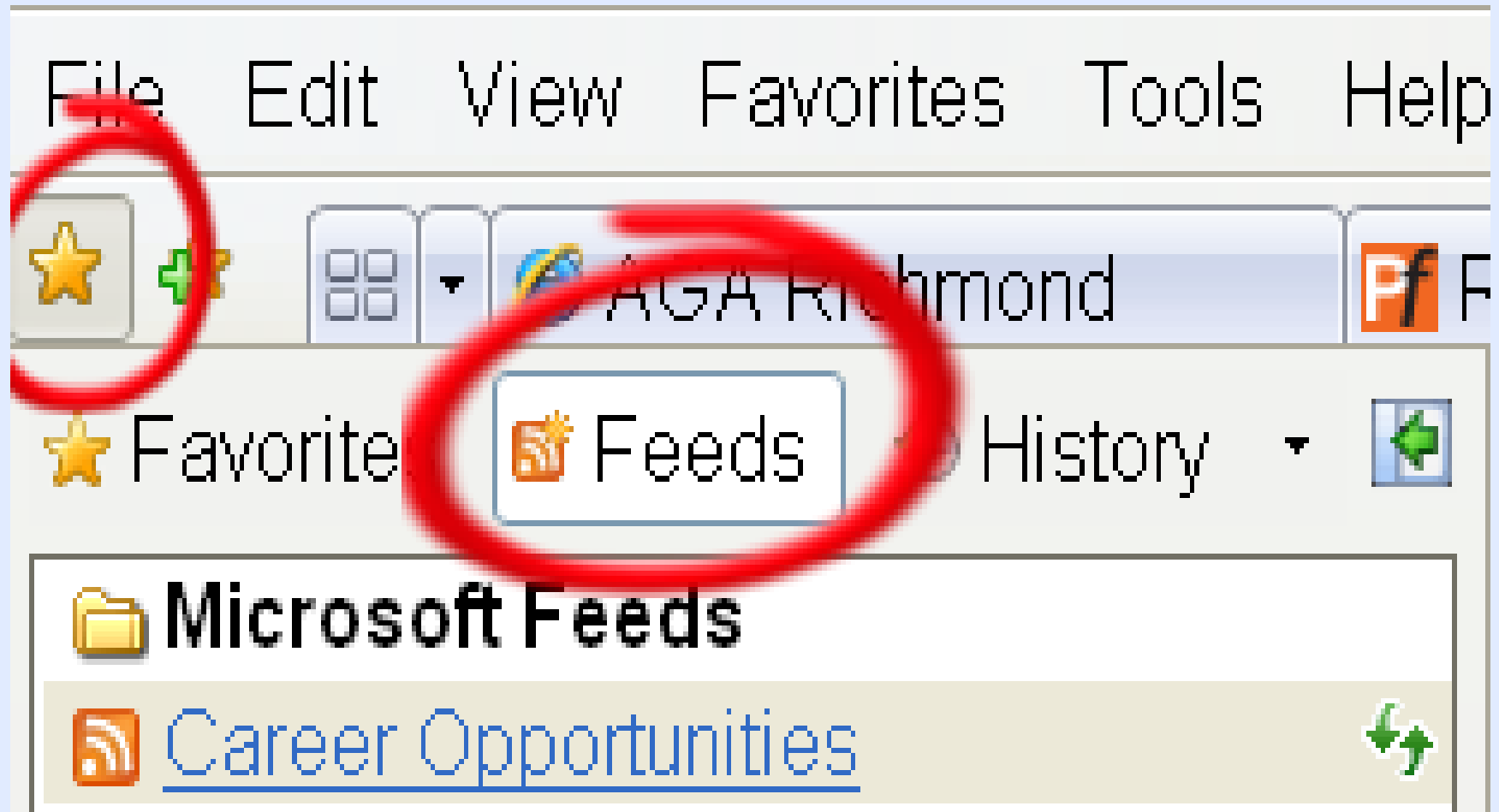
